Kebede was wearing the ultra-light, energy-returning adizero adios BOOST 3.0, featuring adidas' pioneering BOOST technology and drawing on a rich heritage of successes in the Marathon.

The adizero adios debut saw Haile Gebrselassie set the world's best time in Berlin, 2008; a record subsequently broken by Patrick Makau in the same shoe on the same course in 2011. The shoe was then worn by Wilson Kipsang when he broke the course record for the London Marathon in 2014, before Dennis Kimetto went on to run the fastest marathon in history in Berlin later the same year wearing adizero adios BOOST 3.0.

Combining endless energy with lightweight speed, the adizero adios BOOST 3.0, is the ultimate shoe for road racing.
