The Lufthansa lounges in the new Munich Terminal 2 satellite

Lufthansa will double the surface area of its available lounges at the opening of the new Munich Airport Terminal 2 satellite. Five lounges in the Schengen and non-Schengen sectors with a surface area of more than 4,000 square metres will be added to the existing seven lounges in Terminal 2. Currently, Lufthansa offers a First Class lounge, three Senator and two Business lounges as well as a Senator Café with a total of over 4,600 square metres to its guests in Terminal 2.

The new lounges are flooded with light thanks to floor to ceiling panorama windows, and feature a spectacular view of the eastern airfield. The newest Lufthansa lounge design entices guests with warm colours and an inviting atmosphere. The First Class Lounge, the first lounge in the worldwide Lufthansa lounge network, offers a roof terrace.

The new lounges at a glance:

First Class Lounge

- On level 06 with direct access to the departure levels K (Schengen) and L (non-Schengen) and from the non-EU arrivals level
- Access for departing, transferring and incoming first-class passengers and HON Circle members
- Approx. 1,000 square metres and 80 seats: generous wining & dining area, à la carte menus and high quality buffet, bar, cigar lounge, offices and various comfort and relaxation areas
- 100 m² rooftop terrace with lounge furniture and a panorama view of the apron
- 2 relaxation rooms with daybeds
- 4 bathrooms
- Valet parking for private cars and car rentals at the Terminal 2 driveway
- Exclusive check-in counters in the redesigned First Class check-in area and curbside check-in at Terminal 2
- Limousine service for passengers whose aircraft takes off or arrives at an apron location

Senator Lounges

- Lounges on level 04 (K / Schengen) and level 05 (L / non-Schengen)
- Approximately 150 seats over a 900 m² area
- Skybar (level 05) with bartenders or coffee bar (level 04)
- Bistro area, work area, rest rooms, comfort zones, TV lounge
- 5 shower rooms

Business Lounges

- Lounges on level 04 (K / Schengen) and level 05 (L / non-Schengen)
- Approximately 130 seats over a 700 m² area
- Skybar (level 05) with barkeeper
- Bistro area and workspaces, comfort area with recliners, TV zone
- 3 shower rooms
