Elected as one of the youngest Fellows of the Royal Society of Edinburgh, Chris also sits on the boards of TV Squared, Brightsolid Online Technology, Scottish Institute for Enterprise, Dundee Science Centre, and the Royal Scottish National Orchestra.

Mr. Van der Kuyl is also the founding chairman of Entrepreneurial Scotland (ES) which represents all of Scotland's entrepreneurial talent and has the purpose of inspiring, connecting, and developing entrepreneurial behaviour across all Scottish industries.

Mr. Van der Kuyl's appointment to the Six Capital Advisory Board adds to an existing group of distinguished executives, who provide strategic counsel, worldwide networks, and contacts to support the company's growth.
