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THE PENINSULA BANGKOK CELEBRATES 15 YEARS OF RIVERSIDE HERITAGE

The Peninsula Bangkok celebrates its 15th anniversary on 19 November 2013 with a collection of special offers, community engagement and events in honour of the anniversary.

Given The Peninsula Bangkok's spectacular position on the banks of the Chao Phraya River, the anniversary celebrations will also highlight life on the river, including a prestigious photo competition focusing on the places, people, architecture and life that gives the Chao Phraya its special place in the heart of the Thai people. The winning photographs will be used as artwork in the new-look guest rooms and displayed in a special exhibition alongside images from the hotel's past 15 years.

Over 100 staff members who have worked at the hotel since it first opened its doors will be presented with special awards in recognition of their outstanding service.
