THE PENINSULA CHICAGO OPENS ‘THE PENINSULA SKY RINK’ – CHICAGO’S ONLY HOTEL SKATING RINK – FOR SECOND SEASON

The luxury hotel unveils outdoor skating rink, entitled ‘The Peninsula Sky Rink’, overlooking iconic Magnificent Mile, with funds raised to benefit children’s charities

The Peninsula Chicago is pleased to announce the return of The Peninsula Sky Rink for the 2013 – 2014 winter season on Saturday, November 23, 2013. The 2,100 sq ft (200 sq m) hybrid rink is the only hotel skating rink in Chicago and originally debuted in December, 2012. Adjacent to the hotel’s Shanghai Terrace restaurant and four stories above Michigan Avenue, with views of Chicago’s iconic John Hancock building and the “Magnificent Mile,” the skating rink is open to hotel, restaurant and spa guests daily through March 3, 2014. Throughout the season, there will be a variety of events and activities planned. Additionally, skaters will help give back to the local community as 100% of the rink’s skating earnings will be donated to two Chicago children’s charities.

Location and Setting: The Terrace is the perfect backdrop for the hotel’s skating rink. Surrounded by Chicago’s skyscrapers and twinkling lights, the rink is tucked into a pine tree winter wonderland and bathed in festive music and snowflake lighting. Skaters can enjoy the rink in a myriad of weather conditions, perched above Chicago’s bustling Michigan Avenue.

Charities: All monies collected will be donated to two Chicago children’s charities:
