<b>Agronomic Details</b>	The golf course is routed over 137 acres. Putting surfaces are Pennlinks II Bentgrass. Fairways and tees are Tifway II Hybrid Bermuda. The golf course is overseeded every Fall with Palmer Prelude Ryegrass (closure for 21 days).
<b>Staff</b>	Wynn Golf Club is proud to have six Class A members of the PGA of America
<b>Caddies</b>	Caddies are provided with each starting reservation and will provide services such as explanation of each hole, assistance with club selection and green reading and general duties such as bunker raking and divot replacement.
<b>Food &amp; Beverage</b>	Lunch and dinner are served at The Country Club, A New American Steakhouse, which overlooks the 18 <sup>th</sup> hole. On-course refreshment services are provided at the Tee House located adjacent to holes nine and 13.

## **Wynn Golf Course and Country Club**

LAS VEGAS—The second collaboration of Tom Fazio, Steve Wynn and Mother Nature has resulted in 18 unforgettable holes right outside our back door for the use of our guests and other visitors to the Strip. The par-70 course is 7,042 yards in length with Tifway II Hybrid Bermuda grass on the fairways and tees, and its Pennlinks Bentgrass putting greens are built to USGA specifications.

Over 800,000 cubic yards of earth were moved to create the dramatic elevation changes considered impossible on the Las Vegas Strip. To create this new landscape, over 100,000 new shrubs were planted and roughly 1,200 existing trees were salvaged and relocated from the former Desert Inn Golf Course, some more than 50 years old and over 60 feet tall.

In addition to these features, water comes into play in 11 of the 18 holes with 4,600 lineal feet of stream and two marshland areas using natural groundwater. The course culminates with a magnificent 37-foot waterfall as the focal point of the 18th hole and provides a spectacular view for diners at The Country Club, A New American Steakhouse.

Wynn Golf Club occupies the land that was once the storied Desert Inn Golf Club. The Desert Inn Golf Club operated from 1952 until 2002. Construction on Wynn Golf Club began on February 11, 2003 and concluded on April 22, 2005. The first day of operation for Wynn Golf Club was opening day of Wynn Las Vegas, April 28, 2005.

Course designer Tom Fazio's credentials including the design of Shadow Creek Golf Club, Estancia Golf Club, Black Diamond Ranch Golf Club as well as the re-design of classics including Augusta National, the Inverness Club, and Oak Hill Golf Club. No living designer has more credits on Golf Digest's "America's 100 Greatest Golf Courses" list.

The Wynn Golf Club is located in the heart of the resort and provides a traditional clubhouse setting, complete with a lounge, men's and women's full-service locker rooms, pro shop, practice facility, caddy service and professional assistance.
