## T4 debut at Livestock Event tops off eye-catching New Holland display

This tailored offering produces 74-114 hp and benefits from state-of-the-art Common Rail technology with an efficient Cooled Exhaust Gas Recirculation system for Tier 4A compliance, plus deluxe VisionView<sup>™</sup> cab and advanced options such as a Dual Command<sup>™</sup> transmission.





The T5 and TD5 will be showing off their well-known all-rounder capabilities, such as outstanding maneuverability, while the Roll Belt Baler's new design pick up and "endless belt" design will help to deliver significant productivity gains.
