This order, with a three-year extension, comes on the back of a previous framework agreement that has now been completed. With the new agreement, ÖBB Postbus will add more than 200 Crossway and Crossway LE to the Iveco Bus vehicles already in operation.

ÖBB Postbus chose to reinforce its partnership with Iveco Bus for further fleet expansion because of the commitment of the Iveco Bus team and determining factors such as the excellent performance and the advantageous Total Cost of Ownership (TCO) of the Crossway.

The new models that will join the ÖBB Postbus fleet will offer the added benefits of the excellent reliability, fuel efficiency and low maintenance costs of Iveco Bus’s latest Euro VI engines with patented HI-SCR technology, which achieves low emissions levels without exhaust gas recirculation (EGR) and avoiding high-heat operation to clean the Diesel particulate filter. These models also offer greater on-board comfort and quieter operation, as well as the best ergonomic space dedicated to the driver”.*

Undisputed n° 1 in its category in Europe, and true “money-maker” thanks to its versatility and operating profitability, the Crossway has already seen more than 27,000 units roll off the production line since its launch in 2006, continuing to win the affection of European transport groups and bus companies
