Additionally, Givens is involved in the Big Brother Big Sister program, Habitat for Humanity, The National FFA Organization and Toastmasters.

"Chelsea is out there getting to know people. Racine is not just where she works; she is really embracing the community," said Anna Clementi, operations coordinator for the RAMAC. "She absolutely does what she says she is going to do," Clementi said.

Ms. Givens joined CNH Industrial Capital in New Holland, Pennsylvania in 2015 after completing a Bachelors' in Business Administration and Management, earned while working full-time. In Givens' current role as a wholesale support analyst, she supports dealers and acts as a liaison between CNH Industrial Capital and the company's brands.
