IVECO "Made in Kazakhstan" Stahlbau garbage collector body on Eurocargo chassis enters the market.

IVECO announced today the full localization of production of garbage collectors based on its Eurocargo chassis in cooperation with Stahlbau, the specialist in the design of municipal and urban vehicles for the most complex missions in harsh conditions and supplier of municipal vehicles in Kazakhstan. The Stahlbau plant, which is located in Industrial park, Nur-Sultan city, has been certified by different Eurasian government institutions – the Republic of Kazakhstan National Chamber of Entrepreneurs, the Ministry for Industry and Trade of Russia, and the International Quality Center (IQC) – and the vehicle is marketed in the Eurasian Union as "Made in Kazakhstan".

The garbage collector on Eurocargo chassis offers excellent benefits in terms of efficiency and low Total Cost of Ownership. The sustainable and maneuverable Eurocargo is ideal for municipal missions with the narrow turning circle of less than 12 m and short wheelbase of 3690 mm, and the exceptionally low fuel consumption. The 8-mm thick hardox metal allows to increase the structural stiffness of the garbage collector's body. The lightweight chassis construction results in higher payload and carrying weight. The Eurocargo stands out for the variety of available options and wide range of chassis models makes. Eurocargo is equipped with the IVECO EuroV Tector 6-cylinder 6-litre Common Rail engine.
