This competition can break the boundaries set by schools and classes and showcase the rich imagination, creativity, aesthetics and innovative thinking of the students, and in the meantime popularizing national education. Not only can participating students be awarded individually, they can also join as a team. Winning entries will also be exhibited at the participating schools.
