## Wynn's collaboration with local SMEs valued at MOP68 million

**Macau, August 8, 2016** – Wynn Resorts (Macau) S.A. and the Macao Chamber of Commerce (MCC) launched the "Local SME Procurement Partnership Program" earlier this year, a process that supported by Macao Economic Services, Macao Trade and Investment Promotion Institute (IPIM), Macau Productivity and Technology Transfer Center (CPTTM) and the Business Incubation Center for Youth.
