The IWC sake competition was introduced in 2007 and has since become the biggest sake competition outside of Japan and has thus provided an international platform for sake.

In an effort to contribute to the development of the food & beverage and tourism industries in Macau, Wynn will continue to showcase the essence and colors of gastronomy through various kinds of events, such as the recent 'Asia's 50 Best Restaurants 2018' and *The Gastronomic Treasure of Macau* program. All these have provided a platform to facilitate exchange between industry professionals and have helped to promote the food and beverage culture of Macau.
