Acclaimed Chefs Collaborate in Star-Studded Feasts at Wynn in Macau

The star-studded events will feature culinary world masters in Macau, who will use their boundless imagination in blending cooking styles with modern technologies from different countries, showcasing the best-in-class cuisines and latest Asian trends for guests from home and abroad.
