# ON THE WORLD CUP

This is the second time we've qualified for the World Cup. In 2006 we did so well and everybody was satisfied with our performance so now there is more expectation. Luckily this time we'll be playing in Africa so there'll be more African fans supporting us which will be great motivation for us.

Statistically Germany is the best in our group. Since they have done so well in world cup history everybody will expect them to win the group; but Serbia topped their qualifying group beating France so it's not going to be easy. They have a great team and I think right now they have the best team in the group. If you look at the way they qualified – they were unbeaten. But Ghana can be a surprise there... People may think we are underdogs but in football anything can happen. It's not going to be an easy group but we have the quality to surprise. This year at the Under 20 World Cup, an African team won for the first time. So in football anything can happen. It depends on our motivation, concentration and determination. We are expecting to win the World Cup. No African team has ever reached the semi-finals and that's the
